

Bhima Lift Irrigation Project (Major) in Karnataka State

The scheme provides irrigation to the drought prone areas of Afzalpur Taluka in Kalaburagi District (Drought prone area), a boon for the entire region as command area is now getting sufficient water for irrigation.

Gated Barrage across River Bhima, in Krishna basin, started in 1993-94.

2 Foreshore Lift Irrigation Schemes, one on left bank & another on right bank of Bori River.

Benefits of the project include creation of Irrigation Potential of 24292 ha.& also Provides water for drinking & Industrial requirements

The cost of the project is Rs 619.17 crore.

The project was included under Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchai Yojana-Accelerated Irrigation Benefit Program in 2015-16 to fasttrack its completion.

Central Assistance of Rs 335.91 crore is released to the Project.

Timely release of funds and multi-layered monitoring of the project under PMKSY-AIBP helped overcome several long-pending issues, and led to its early completion.

About 47 Water User Associations (WUA) are reported to be registered & active in the project area.
