

Sindh Phase-II (Major) Multipurpose Project, Madhya Pradesh

Sindh Project Phase-II is a multipurpose major irrigation project across Sindh River in Distt. Shivpuri. Sindh Project Phase-II comprises Construction of main Atal Sagar (Madikheda) Dam across Sindh river to impound 901.81 MCM of water; five canal systems viz. (1) Ukaila Canal (2) Right Bank Canal (Upto Mahuar river) (3) Right Bank Canal (Beyond Mahuar river) (4) Left Bank Canal (Doab canal) and (5) Harsi High Level Canal.

Among Benefits are annual irrigation to an area of 162100 ha in Shivpuri, Datia, Gwalior and Bhind districts and generation of 60 MW of hydro power.

The cost of the AIBP components of project is Rs 1924.83 crore. Central Assistance of Rs 640.56 crore is released to the Project.

Timely release of funds and multi-layered monitoring of the project under PMKSY-AIBP helped overcome several long-pending issues, and led to its early completion. All 49 Water User Associations (WUA) are reported to be registered & active in the project area. CAD works are under progress.
