Singhpur Barrage (Medium) irrigation Project, Madhya Pradesh

This project originally planned in 1979-80 extends irrigation facilities in the downstream areas of Urmil dam in Chhatarpur district. The project proposes to use MP's share of Urmil waters and water from the independent catchment of 257.71 sq.km. between Urmil dam and Singhpur barrage in Madhya Pradesh territory.


Benefits of the project covers annual irrigation to an area of 10,200 ha in Chhatarpur district. Total CCA of the project is 6,000 ha. The project was included in AIBP in 2011-12.

The cost of the project is Rs 180.09 crore.



Central Assistance of Rs 32.49croreis released to the Project.
